The abstract should summarize the contents of the paper and should contain at least 70 and at most 180 words. The page style is in accordance with Springer-Verlag LNCS format. (basic_text)

The printing area is 122mm x 193mm. The text should be justified to occupy the full line width, so that the right margin is not ragged, with words hyphenated as appropriate. Please fill pages so that the length of the text is no less than 180mm. Use 10-point type for the name(s) of the author(s) and 9-point type for the address(es). For the abstract text, please use 10-point type and single-line spacing. We recommend using Computer Modern Roman (CM) fonts, Times New Roman, or one of the similar type-faces.




Fig. 1. This is a sample figure caption. The last sentence of a figure caption should generally end without a period (figure_legend)

Authors are encouraged to add one or two figures to better present the thematic. Please add the figure caption and position it under the figure. Center the caption between the margins and set it in 9-point type (Fig. 1 shows an example). The distance between text and figure should be about 8mm, the distance between figure and caption about 5mm.
